What is a Geospatial Environmental Scan[®]?

A Geospatial Environmental Scan[®] (GeoEScan[®]) is an information gathering process and a resulting information product. As a process, it is a systematic collection and analysis of information to identify and forecast local population characteristics, health needs, social determinants of health, resource availability, and other factors that may strengthen or threaten population wellbeing. The information product that results from the process provides an interactive tool that can be used to explore select characteristics at multiple geographic levels. The GeoEScan[®] uses Geographic Information System (GIS) applications to capture, integrate, analyze, and display data.

Why Use It?

The goal of the GeoEScan[®] is to provide the most reliable, meaningful data at the smallest geography possible without releasing any protected health information (PHI). For our maps, this requires that we protect individuals from being identified while still showing the geographic variations that can be useful in policy development and programming, such as mapping at the ZIP Code Tabulation Area (ZCTA) level. Using ZCTA-level data provides a good compromise between protecting health information, ensuring rates are reliable, and showing geographic variation at a finer level. The GeoEScan[®] presents a platform to examine the social determinants of health (SDoH) and their association with and impact on birth outcomes. These maps help users to **connect health and place; to identify communities of opportunity; and to evaluate** areas for further research, program development, or outreach efforts.

Other maps included in the GeoEScan[®] allow users to identify individual ZCTAs by place name. ZCTA- and county-level data tables also are provided. The information contained in the GeoEScan[®] provides a contextual framework to explore birth outcomes and SDoH.

What are ZIP Code Tabulation Areas?

ZIP Code Tabulation Areas (ZCTAs) are approximate area representations of U.S. Postal Service five-digit ZIP Code service areas used by the Census Bureau to present statistical data from censuses and surveys. See the Metadata for additional details.

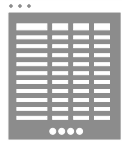

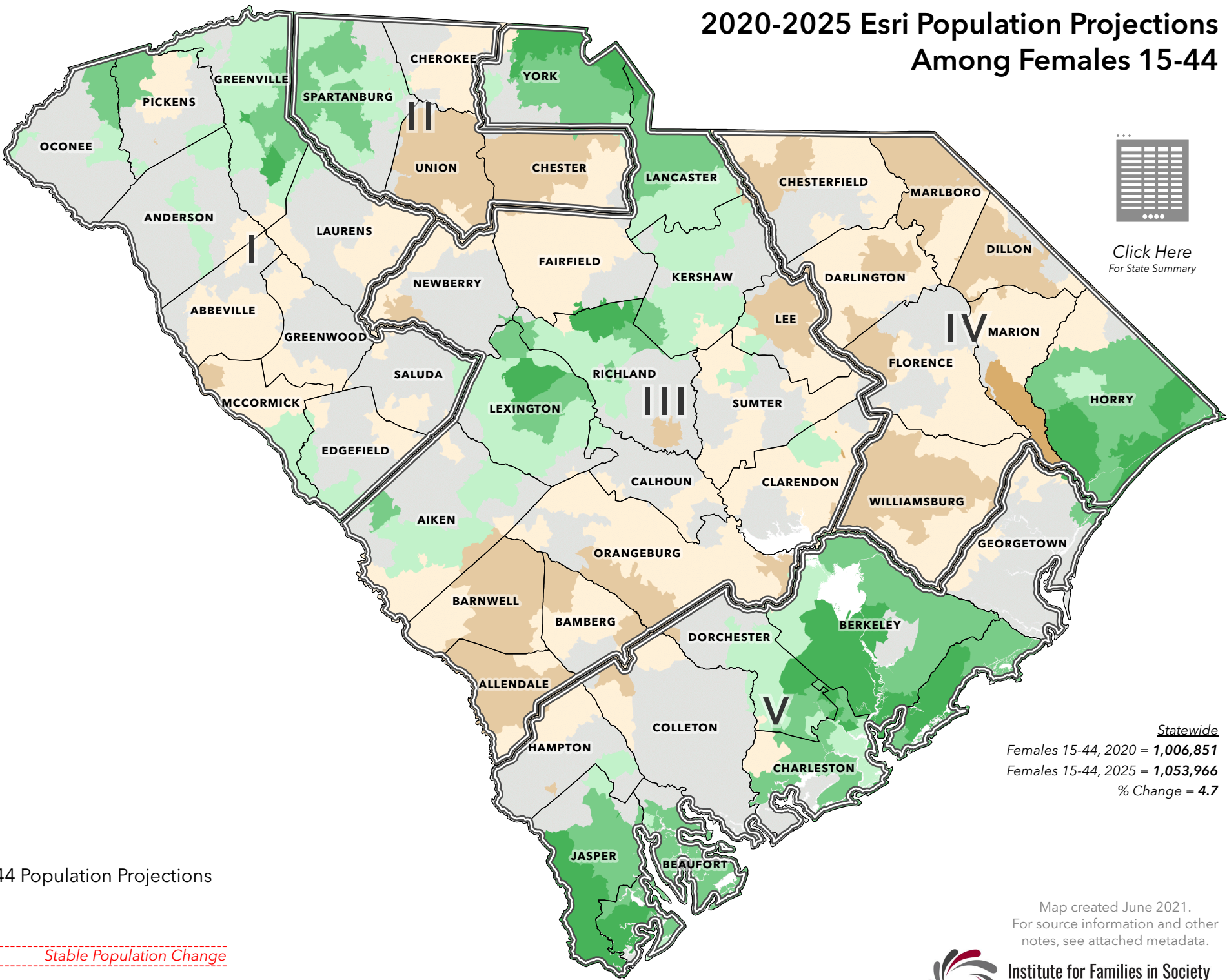

2020-2025 Esri Population Projections Among Females 15-44

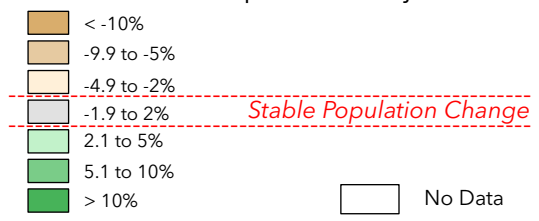

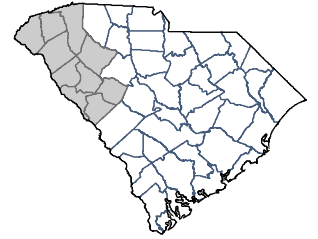

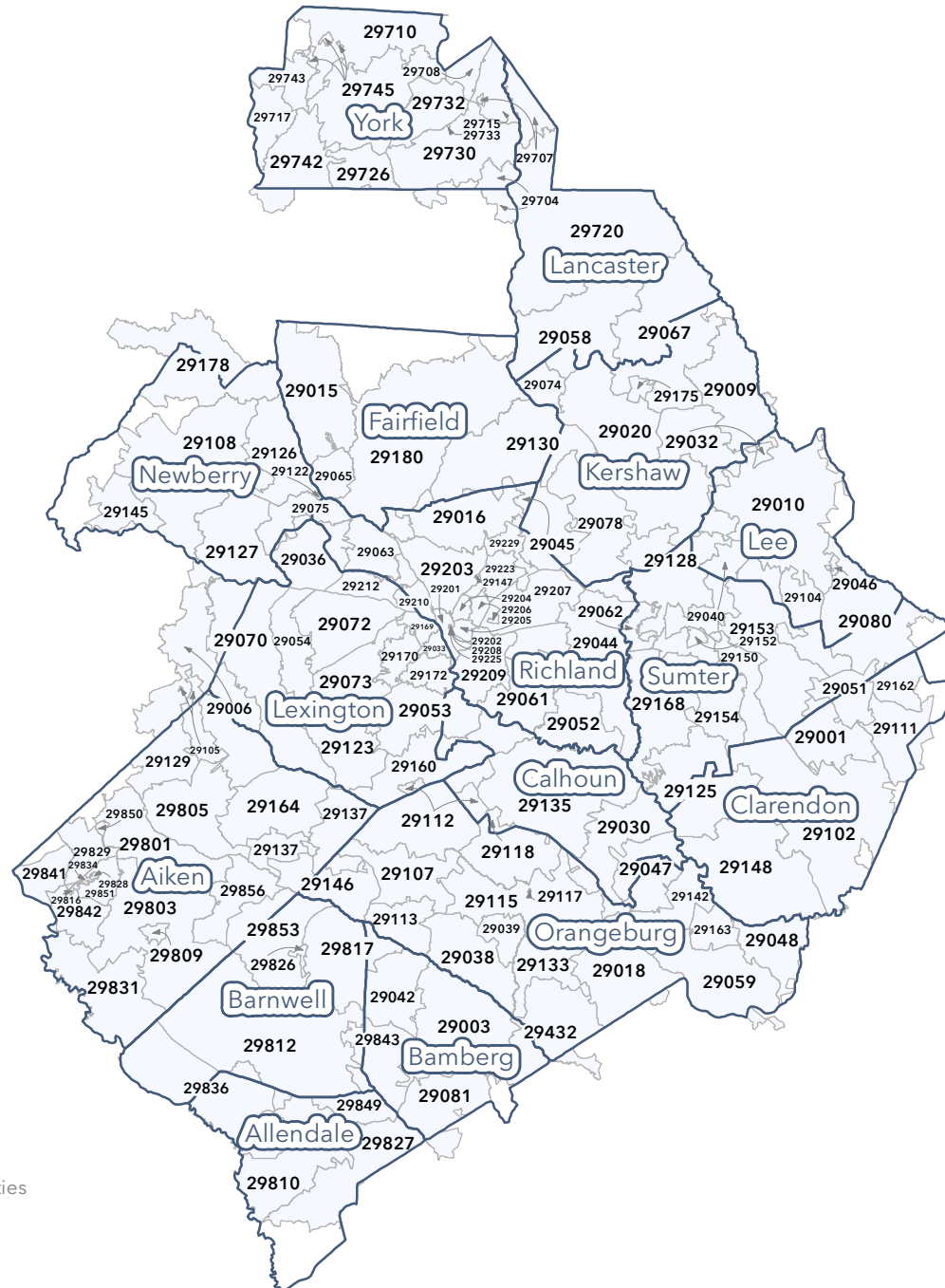
SC DHEC Perinatal Region III ZIP Code Tabulation Area (ZCTA) Locator Map

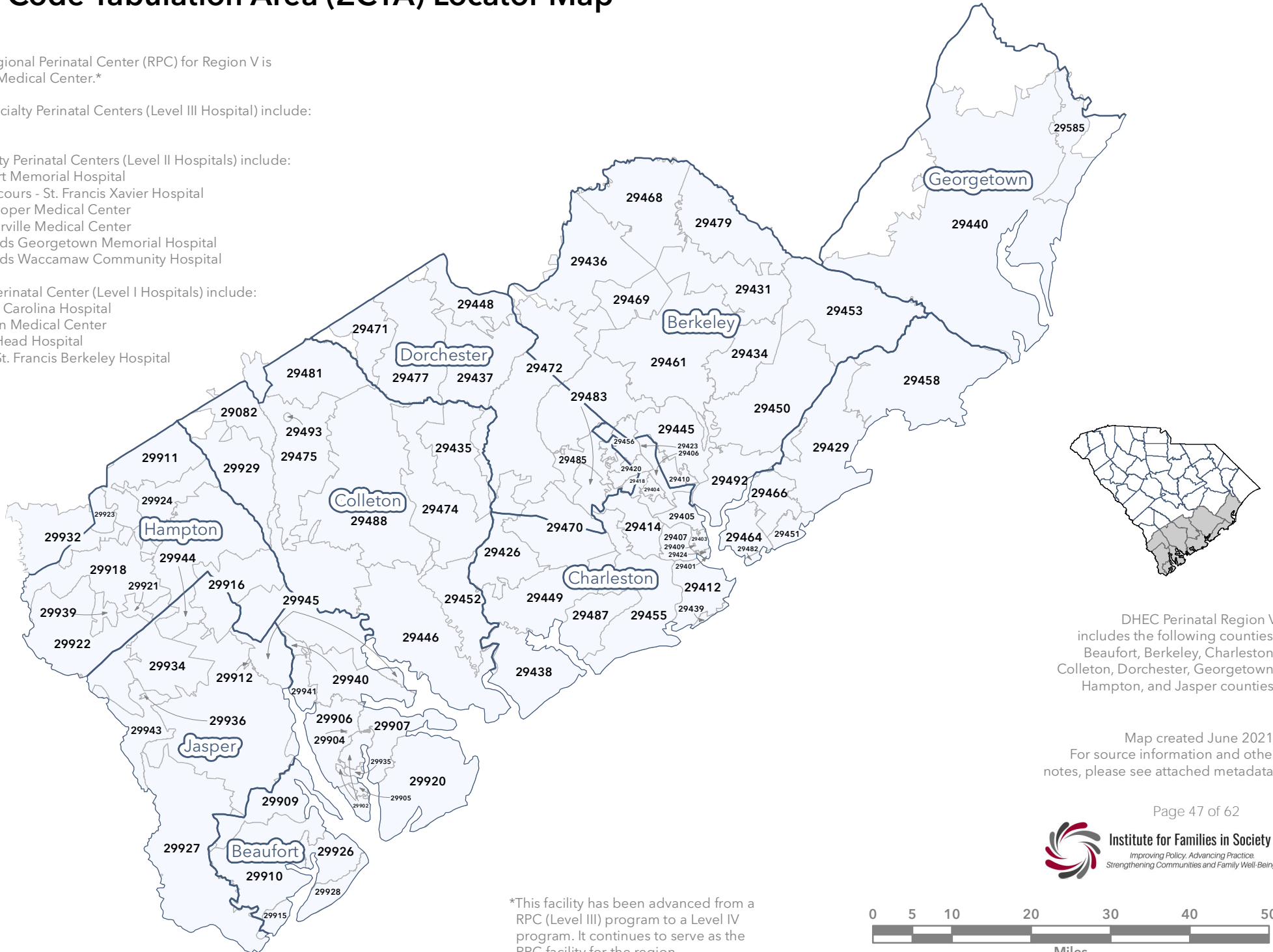
