SUBLOCADE® Co-Payment Assistance

Program Eligibility

- Patients must be prescribed SUBLOCADE® by their treatment provider.
- Patients must have private health insurance that provides coverage for some portion of the cost of SUBLOCADE® under a medical or pharmacy benefit plan, and that has not prohibited use of coupons/co-pay assistance for SUBLOCADE®.
- Patients must be residents of the United States and reside in a state that does not prohibit co-pay assistance.
- Patients must be between the ages of 18 and 65.

Program Benefits

- This benefit is valid for the out-of-pocket cost of SUBLOCADE® only. It is not valid for any other out-of-pocket costs including costs associated with the administration of SUBLOCADE® (for example, office visit or medication administration charges).
- Eligible patients will receive co-pay assistance of up to \$1,920.50 for the first two SUBLOCADE® injections of each calendar year.
- Assistance of up to \$800 will be provided for any subsequent injections in the same calendar year.
- The Program benefit may be applied for a maximum of 14 injections per calendar year and requires that there must be a minimum of 23 days between dates of service. The maximum possible annual benefit is \$13,441.

The Co-pay Assistance Program is not valid for insured individuals or patients with government insurance including, but not limited to, Medicare, Medicaid, Medigap, VA, DOD, TRICARE, CHAMPVA or any other federally or state-funded government-assisted program.
